

## STRAWBERRY FIELD TRIP VOCABULARY WORDS

**Farm** – a place where crops are grown.

**Farmer** – a person who raises crops

**Crops** – a plant that can be grown and harvested.

**Harvest** – the gathering (or picking) of a crop

**Strawberry** – A juicy, red fruit that you can eat—yummy.

**Plant** – (verb) to put or set in the ground to grow.  
(noun) the leafy, green part of the strawberry plant.

**Bloom** – the flowering part of the strawberry plant.

**Honey Bee** – an insect that feeds on pollen and nectar and produces honey.

**Hive** – a home for honeybees

**Pollinate** – when a honeybee feeds on the strawberry bloom.

**Field** – an area of land used for planting crops (a place where the strawberries are grown).

**Acre** – An area of land that is a slightly smaller than a football field.

**Irrigate** – to put water on plants

**Frost** – a covering of tiny ice crystals on a cold surface

**Frost Protecting** – a process used to keep the strawberry plant and strawberries from freezing.

**Tractor** – a vehicle used for pulling farm tool such as a plow or wagon.
